


## Guidance for Building Officials for Private Residence Elevators

1. To confirm the private residence elevator is under permit with CECA, look for a label and/or a posted permit at or near the elevator controller.






2. Search the status of the device by going to **www.CECAPRDRegistry.com** and entering the Unit ID # in the **SEARCH** bar.





3. The current status of the elevating device will be shown, confirm the device permit is listed as "complete" and the device address is correct.



- 4. If the private residence elevator does not have a CECA permit, consider taking the following actions before issuing an occupancy permit.
  - a. Require a completed CECA Permit and CECA ID Label
  - b. Require an inspection be performed on the elevating device by a QEI certified elevator inspector to confirm compliance with applicable codes and standards.
  - c. Accept the elevating device, without any verification of compliance, as part of the occupancy permit without taking any further action.
